CA-2026-041 In accordance with By-law 135-2017 as amended, the Community Services and Infrastructure Services Departments are providing notification that:

- Hibernia Street, from Forman Avenue to Avondale Avenue, and Huntingdon Avenue, from Huron Street to Feick Crescent, will be closed Wednesday, April 8, 2026, for several hours beginning at approximately 9:00 a.m. to allow for the safe and efficient repair of a watermain break located in the intersection of Hibernia Street and Huntingdon Avenue. No through traffic at the intersection, local traffic only.
- Waterloo Street from Downie Street to Douro Street will be closed to through traffic, on Monday, April 13 from 7:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. This road closure is to facilitate the installation of infrastructure for 209 Waterloo Street.
- For about 8 weeks, beginning April 13, 2026 until approximately June 5, 2026, to support concrete repairs on the John Street Bridge over the Avon River, John Street will be reduced to a single lane, with a portable traffic signal in place to control two-way traffic. In addition, Centre Street at John Street will be closed.
- Taylor Street from Norfolk Street to Elgin Crescent will be closed to through traffic, local traffic only, on Tuesday, April 14 from 7:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. This road closure is to facilitate the installation of infrastructure for 209 Waterloo Street.
- The intersection of Patricia Road and Kathryn Crescent will be closed Tuesday, April 14, 2026, for several hours beginning at approximately 3:00 p.m. to allow for the safe and efficient repair

of a watermain break at 141 Patricia Road. No through traffic due to open excavation.

- Waterloo Street S, from Ontario Street to Albert Street, will be closed Monday, April 20, 2026, for several hours beginning at approximately 8:00 a.m. to allow for the safe and efficient repair of a leaking watermain valve at 161 Ontario Street.
