## **RECREATION PROGRAMMING**

- Fall/Winter program is in full operation with sport groups, 35+ and 55+ programming occurring throughout the day and evening hours at the Agriplex. Many popular classes are sold out like LivFit and Yoga Level 1 at the Tom Patterson Theatre.
- The Agriplex Fieldhouse starts the tournament season in late October with a High School tournament on October 28.
- The Stratford Lakeside Active Adults Association hosted a successful Health and Wellness Open House on September 28, with over 120 people in attendance and thirty new memberships sold. Also, SLAAA hosted Oktoberfest on the evening of October 3 at the Stratford Agriplex. Over one hundred tickets were sold, and many enjoyed an authentic meal and were entertained by the Black Forest Band.
- Staff continue to work on Santa's Parade of Lights happening December 3 at 5pm.

# FACILITIES

- The ice has been installed at Rink A at the Rotary Complex, and ice rentals started on October 1<sup>st</sup>. All four ice surfaces are now operational for the 2023/2024 season.
- The Field House flooring has been re-installed at the Agriplex. Programming in the Field House started on October 15<sup>th</sup>.
- The Splash Pad and washrooms at Anne Hathaway Park closed for the season on September 27<sup>th</sup>.
- The seasonal washrooms including Upper Queens Park, William Allman Memorial Arena (exterior), North Shore, SERC, and Packham Sports Complex closed for the season on October 10<sup>th</sup>.
- Facility Maintenance staff is completing the shutdown and winterization of the seasonal washrooms and recreation facilities.

# **FACILITIES CAPITAL**

- The Tender for the replacement of the upper and lower roofing systems at 47 Downie Street was awarded to Nedlaw Roofing Ltd. in the amount of \$153,035.90. This project is scheduled to start on October 30<sup>th</sup>.
- The Tender for the replacement of the upper roofing system at the Stratford Public Library was awarded to Smith-Peat Roofing and Sheet Metal Ltd. in the amount of \$167,420.80. This project started on October 16<sup>th</sup>.
