RECREATION PROGRAMMING

- Indoor Events Staff are currently working with roughly 20 groups/organizations on logistics for upcoming indoor events
- Outdoor Events Staff are currently working through 31 Outdoor Special Event Applications for the upcoming spring/summer season
- Canada Day parade float registration will open the beginning of May
- Market Square Music concert series will occur on Friday evenings at 630pm with the rain date being Saturdays at 1030am. The series will begin May 24 and continue through until June 28. Two highlights with the concert series are Dayna Manning will be doing a sing-along on June 15 and an Indigenous Artist, Christin Dennis, will be performing on National Indigenous Peoples Day, June 21.
- Registration continues for summer programming for day camps and swim lessons
- Sport leagues and tournaments at the Agriplex are coming to a completion for the 2023-24 indoor season
- Senior Lakeside Active Adults Association continues to expand with over 700 members. The
 association is currently shifting their focus to their summer programming schedule

FACILITIES

- The ice surface at the Dufferin Lions Arena was removed on April 6th following the completion of the ice season. Recreation Facility Operator staff are now performing the end of season maintenance at the Dufferin Lions Arena. On April 18th staff will transition to the Packham Sports Complex for the spring and summer months.
- The Packham Sports Complex baseball diamonds are scheduled to open for the season on May 6th.
- The Rink B ice surface at the Rotary Complex was removed on March 28th in advance of the Canadian Dairy XPO event. The Rink B ice surface will be re-installed in late September following the Stratford Fall Fair event. The Rink A ice surface will remain in for the spring and summer months.
- The ice surface at the William Allman Memorial Arena will be removed starting on May 9th following the completion of the ice season at the facility.
- The SERC Basketball Court was opened for the season on April 5th.
- The SERC Tennis/Pickleball Courts, and Shakespeare Park Tennis/Pickleball Courts were opened for the season on April 9th. The construction project at the Milton Park Tennis/Pickleball Courts is scheduled to be completed in mid-May. Those courts will be reopened following the completion of the project.

• The seasonal washrooms at Upper Queens Park, William Allman Memorial Arena (exterior), North Shore, and SERC are scheduled to open for the season on April 26th. The washrooms will be open daily from 9 am to 9 pm, with the exception of the SERC washroom. The SERC washroom will be closed during the daytime on Monday to Friday until the school year is finished to avoid damage and vandalism to the facility.
